Substance misuse has had a devastating impact on families in the United States.


According to the Centers for Disease Control, 144 people per day die of drug overdoses while admissions to treatment for prescription opiates has increased 500 percent.


Overdose Epidemic Nationally

- Over 50,000 drug overdose deaths in the United States in 2016
- More than 135 people every day die from overdose
- Outpaces homicides and traffic accidents
- Some parts of the country have been hit harder than others

Age-adjusted death rates (per 100,000) for overdose deaths from all opioid drugs





Fentanyl is a deadly synthetic opioid that is dozens of times stronger than morphine and heroin




Fentanyl on the Rise Nationally
