The Ohio Mid-Eastern Governments Association (OMEGA) has an immediate opening for a Regional Mobility & Transit Planner to manage OMEGA's Coordinated Human Services Transportation Pilot Program. A Bachelor's Degree in city/regional planning or related field and a minimum of three years of relevant experience is required. (A master's degree or program management experience may substitute for the three-year experience requirement.)

This position will require knowledge and interest in the transportation needs of non-drivers including seniors and people with disabilities and employers; experience in working with the general public, elected officials, and local mobility/transit professionals; demonstration of effective meeting planning and facilitation skills; strong research, data analysis, and writing skills; knowledge of data and information sources used in transportation planning, including Census datasets; proficiency in the use of various software (MS Office Suite, mapping software); and superb communication skills.

The Regional Mobility & Transit Planner conducts public outreach, organizes and facilitates meetings with stakeholders (i.e., senior population, people with disabilities, non-drivers, employers, and other interested parties); conducts surveys, analyzes data, uses data visualization techniques, conducts origin and destination studies, attends local and state transportation planning meetings, and updates the Regional Coordinated Plan. The Planner also facilitates regular, regional coordination meetings with the Regional Coordinated Council, mobility managers, stakeholders, the public including older adults, people with disabilities, non-drivers, employers, and other interested parties.

This is a full-time, 40-hour per week, hybrid position. The successful candidate must possess a current valid driver's license and be willing to attend evening meetings. Salary is based upon education and experience; ranging from \$52,000 to \$58,000.
